Awards

Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special Rosette and pole. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin.

Move-Up Regulations

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day to day move ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes

Of the last dog completing the course.

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm up jump will be provided.

Class Information and Obstacles

Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Regular and Preferred Premier Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. Travel to Santa Rosa Fairgrounds

Directions:

Take highway 101 to Santa Rosa. Exit onto highway 12 eastbound towards Sonoma. Exit highway 12 at the South E Street/Downtown exit. Upon reaching the surface street, Bennet Valley Road, you will come to a stoplight. On the right will be the Sonoma County Fairgrounds. Turn right and travel to the stop sign. At the stop sign turn right. The back gate to the Fairgrounds will be on your right. If you are coming by highway 12 westbound, take the Downtown Exit and turn left at the top light and travel to the stop sign. At the stop sign turn right. The back gate to the Fairgrounds will be on your right. Parking is available inside the fairgrounds near the rings. There may be a parking fee to enter the grounds.

Those who have been fully vaccinated against COVID are not required to wear a face mask. All others are required to wear a face mask unless they are in their personal vehicle or in their personal crating area.

By signing entry form for this event exhibitor agrees to the following: I attest to the best of my knowledge that I do not have COVID at the time of attending this event. I also attest that I have not knowingly been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID within the past 14 days. I will follow all AKC, Hosting Club, City, County and State rules and requirements to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus during the event.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing /Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form
- Running order will be determine by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dog separated as much as possible
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason there will be NO refund of entry fee
- After closing bitches in season will receive refund of amount paid less \$10 per day processing fee
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee
- Refunds are sent seven days after the event
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

Classes Offered Each Day & Show Hours
